Wiltshire Police Report:

Wiltshire Councillors Report:

Cllr Jerry Kunkler presented:

- Wiltshire Police – Precept rise to be 2.0% this coming year
- Wiltshire Police reminder that Tel number 101 is to be used for any NON_Emergency calls
- PCAP –
 - a) £3.4k to be provided to provide BMX Park in Pewsey
 - b) £250 to be provided to pewsey school charity SPLITZ – Caring for children from split homes

- Great British Spring Clean: 3rd- 5th March 2017. - The Clean for the Queen Spring Clean volunteering last year and a request was made for the Board to set aside some money for the Great British Spring Clean in March. Parishes, schools, clubs and organisations were encouraged to organise a litter pick in their areas.
- Cat G (Community Area Transport Group) – It has been agreed that no new projects will be added until the remaining outstanding events to include Havering Lane & Old Severalls Lane had been completed for the Area Board listings – These are scheduled for this year 2017 now.
- Little Salisbury – Concerns have been expressed regarding the speeding issues on the B3087.
- Wiltshire Council budgets must be further reduced over the next 3 years by a further £13m (2017/18) and then £9m & £7m thereafter.
